At he Singing Grass, you'll experience complete privacy in a secluded patch of the world's last great wilderness.



The area includes approximately 30,000 square km of land, including the park and game reserves.








Soar over the vast plains, set off on a walking safari with your knowledgeable guide, or take to the tracks in the back of a four-wheel drive.

From Africa's big five to the annual migration of the wildebeest, the greatest show on earth, nature is just waiting to be explored.






